FREE OPEN EVENTS

At our Open Events see the teaching of early language and reading, including phonics, in the EYFS and KS1.

The Yorkshire Endeavour English Hub will provide:

- Two free places per school at an Open Event. Headteachers, Deputy Heads/Assistant Heads and Senior Leaders with a responsibility for phonics or early reading should attend.
- A review of action planning following attendance at an Open Event;
- Potential funding of up to £6,000 per school to invest in resources or training. This may be fully-funded or match-funded depending upon the circumstances of your school. Resources must meet certain criteria;
- An opportunity to apply for more intensive support from the English Hub (free of charge) including:
- A full audit of a school's early language and phonics provision carried out by one of our experienced Literacy Specialists and support with further action planning;
- Up to six days of school-to-school support led by one of our Literacy Specialists over the period of a year;
- £250 will be paid to the school of each participant to cover release/travel costs and writing an action plan (maximum 2 attendees per school). *Please note, this will only be paid to schools for attendance at our Open Events, not our launch events).
